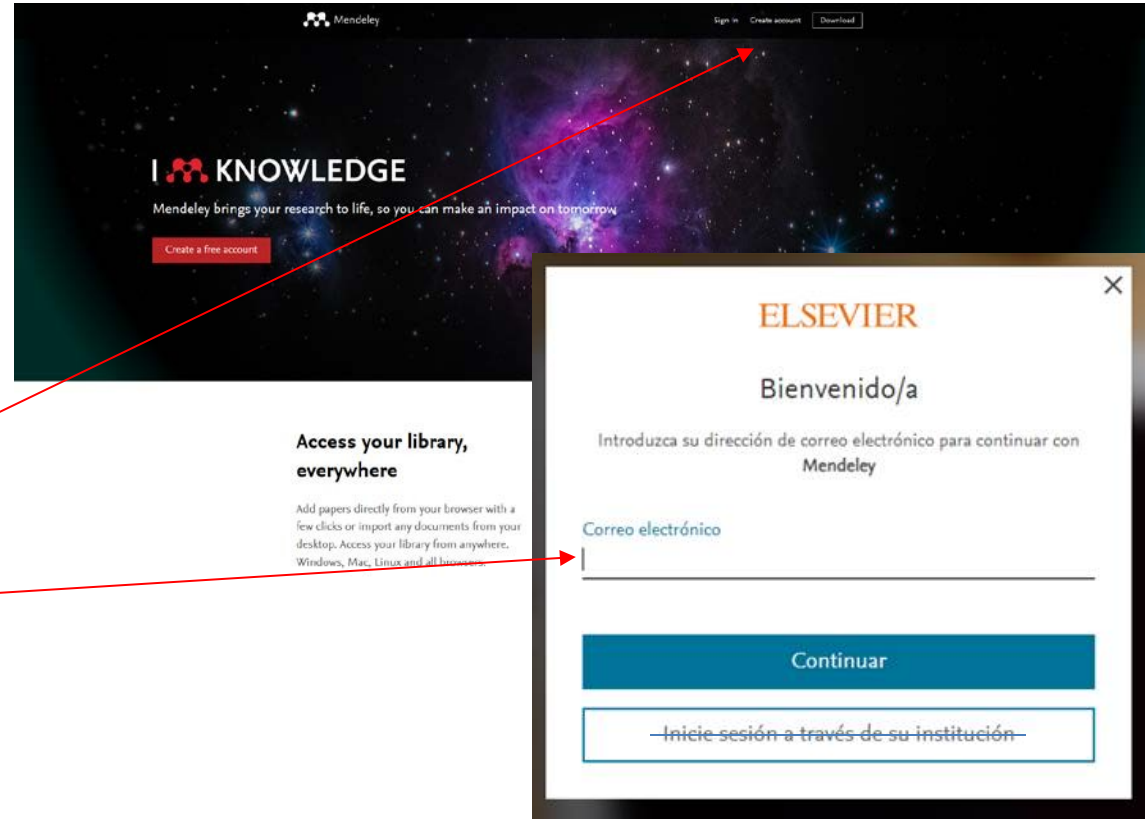


# Mendeley: create an account

You must be connected to the IQS network, and access to the following link: [Mendeley](#)

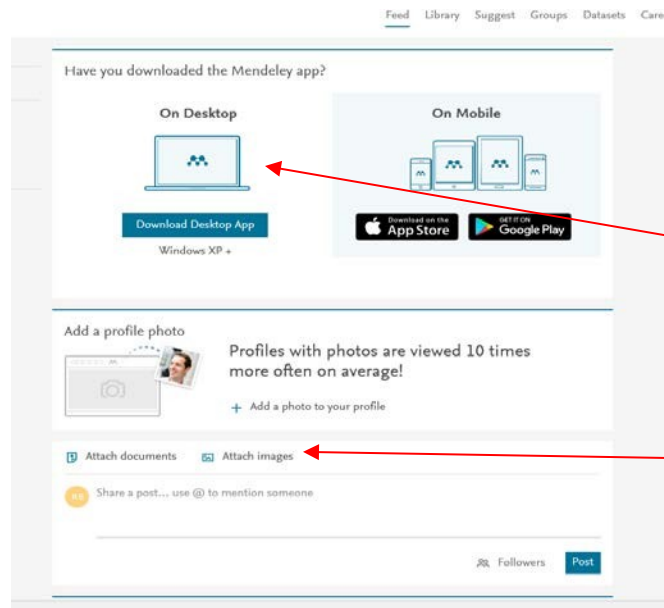
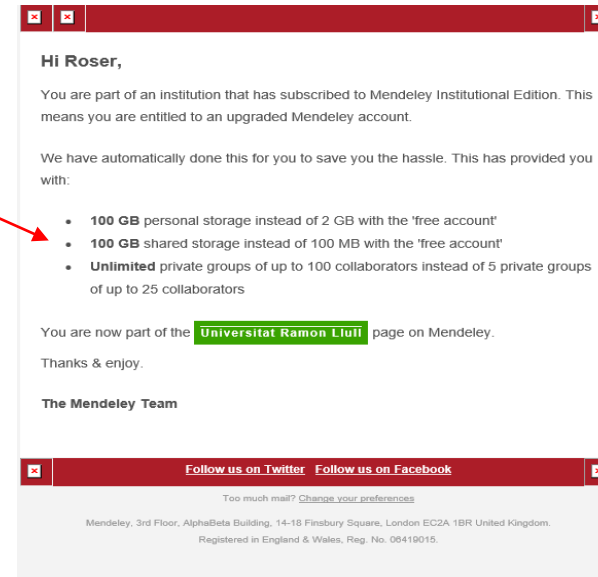
IQS has an institutional version (MIE) with additional advantages that they can only be accessed by registering from our network.

Register with your institutional e-mail (*@iqs.url.edu*) in the option “Create an account”.



# Mendeley: create an account

The program will show you the advantages of your MIE account, and it will tell you the following steps to follow.



Step 1: Install the desktop version  
(Desktop App)

Step 2: Create your research profile

# Mendeley: create an account

Step 3: Install the *Web importer* that it will make easier for you to export references from most databases.

Step 4: Install the *Citation plugin* that it will facilitate the insertion of citations and the creation of bibliographies in your research work.

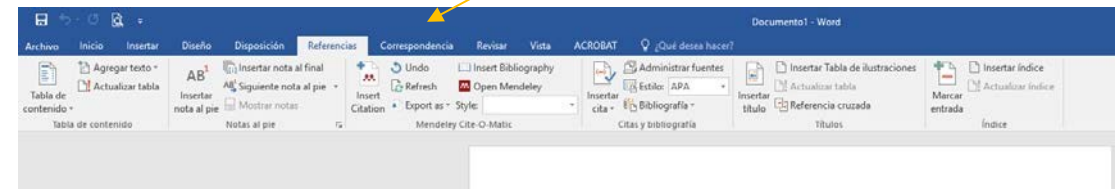

Mendeley has plug-ins for Word, LibreOffice and BibTeX. We cover thousands of citation styles and you can even create your own.

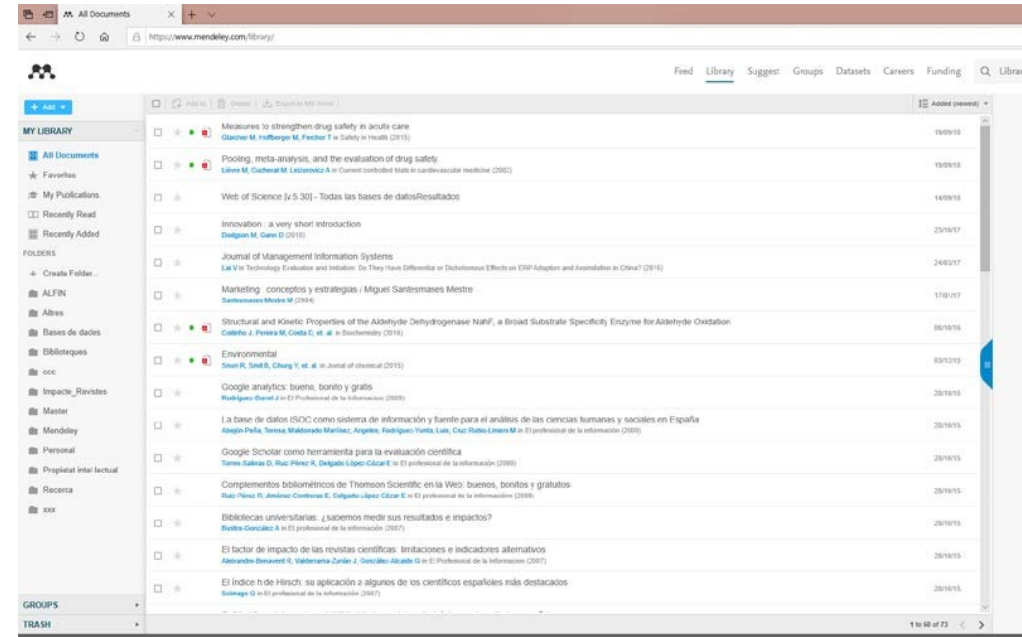
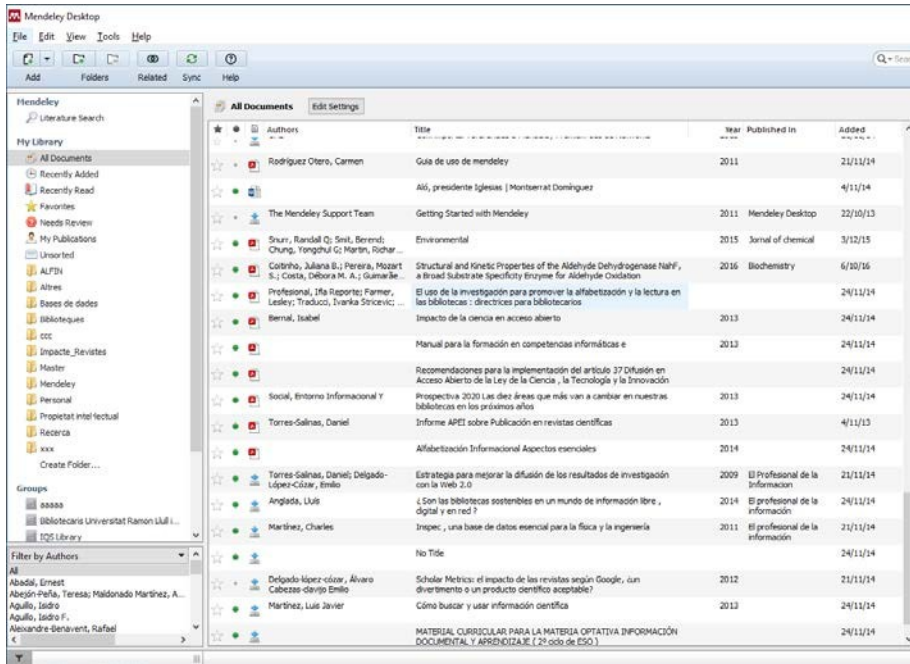

## **To consider!!**

The MIE version of the account and its advantages are active as long as continuous use of the resource is made.

After 12 months of inactivity or access from outside the institution, the account will lose these benefits.


The data is not lost, but to reactivate the benefits you must login from the IQS network.
